

# **TRANSPORTATION RESOURCES**

The following is a selection of programs and companies offering transportation to seniors and disabled residents of Wake County.

### Public and Volunteer Transportation Programs

(W) = wheelchair-accessible vehicles

• Hours of operation: Monday-Friday, 8:15 a.m. - 4:45 p.m.

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- Fixed-route public bus service open to all ages.
- Trip fee (one-way): \$1.25. With GoRaleigh ID, riders ages 65+ are eligible for free fares and riders with a disability are eligible for discounted fares (1/2 rate). To obtain GoRaleigh ID, call to request an application or download one from the website.
- Wake Forest-Raleigh Express connects Raleigh and Wake Forest.
- **MicroLink** is GoRaleigh's new on-demand microtransit service. MicroLink will provide service to the Town of Rolesville as well as connections to popular destinations in Wake Forest, and the WRX service to downtown Raleigh. Rolesville's MicroLink service is a **pilot** that will continue through June 30, 2025. The easiest way to request a ride is through the MicroLink App. Rides can also be booked by calling our reservation center at (**919**) **996-3459**. Does **not** offer advanced booking.

- Curb-to-curb paratransit service for residents of Wake, Durham and Orange counties with a disability.
- **Application required** (unless you are already certified with GoCary or GoRaleigh); applications available online, or can be requested via phone.
- Trip fee (one-way): \$2.50.

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- Fixed-route public bus service open to all ages.
- Full rate one-way trip fares: \$2.50 for regional routes
- Riders ages 65+ are eligible for free fares and riders with a disability are eligible for discounted fares (1/2 rate).
- Wake Forest Loop operates within Wake Forest.

- Low-cost door-to-door, public shared-ride service for trips originating or ending outside Raleigh and Cary city limits, for individuals ages 60+ and/or with a disability.
- No application required; verification of age or disability may be requested.
- Trips may be scheduled same day and <u>no more than 24 hours in advance</u>. Please note: Service is on a first-come, seat-available basis; seats are very limited.
- One-way fares: \$2.00 within zone; \$4.00 between zones (call or go online for detailed zone information).
- Hours of operation: Monday-Saturday, 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. (excluding holidays).

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• GoWake SmartRide NE offers rideshare options for the residents of Zebulon, Wendell, Knightdale and the unincorporated areas in between.

- To request a ride, you can use the GoAccess! app or call the GoWake Access call center
- Fare: **Free**

- Transportation for Medicaid recipients, to medical appointments covered by Medicaid.
- Must schedule 3-5 business days in advance.
- Please note: This office handles many transportation programs; be sure to specify "Medicaid Transportation."
- No fee.

- Volunteer-based service for cancer patients, for transport to and from cancer therapy appointments.
- No fee.
- Riders must be ambulatory or traveling with someone who is capable of assisting
