Information, Referral, and Case Assistance

Helping the Wake County community find information about resources is central to the mission of Resources for Seniors. The Information Department staff can listen to your situation, help you determine and find the right services, and direct you to the appropriate agencies. Assistance may be provided by telephone, email, or through a brief consultation visit (call for an appointment).

Fee: Free

Housing and Home Improvement

For eligible seniors 60+ years of age, the Housing and Home Improvement Program provides installation of safety and accessibility equipment such as ramps and grab bars. At this time, the program does **NOT** assist with any minor or major home repairs.

Fee: Sliding-scale fees for some services

Weatherization Services

Provides upgrades and repairs to make homes easier to heat and cool. Available to low-income homeowners and some renters.

Fee: Free

Housing Resources

Offers information on local housing options, including affordable senior housing, retirement communities, and long-term care facilities.

These centers provide adult day services for older adults who require supervision during the day. Services include enrichment programs, nutritious meals, and caregiver respite.

Fee: Limited public funding available through the RFS Adult Day Care Funding Program or private pay

Respite and Wake Independence at Home

Resources for Seniors administers public funding for programs that provide limited home care at subsidized rates for Wake County residents who have no caregiver or whose caregivers need a break from caregiving. These programs typically have long waiting lists. Contact our Information Department at **919-713-1556** to learn more.

Community Alternatives Program for Disabled Adults (CAP/DA)

This is a Medicaid-funded state program offering in-home care for those clients who might otherwise require nursing home care.

Note: RFS only does two things in CAP/DA:

- Submit the referral (not the official application)
- Serve as Case Managers if the client chooses RFS

- Clients can pick from several case management agencies
 - Case Managers only work with assigned clients who are actively enrolled in CAP/DA

Transportation

Limited medical transportation is available for seniors age 60 and older who have no other transportation options. Lengthy waitlist may apply.

Fee: Free

Note: Seniors with full Medicaid are not eligible for this service, as they receive transportation through GoWake Access.

Options Counseling

Provides guidance for seniors and individuals with disabilities to access community supports and services. Helps individuals navigate available programs and make informed decisions about long-term care options.

Caregiver Support Groups

Various support groups (Alzheimer's/dementia, general caregiving, grief, etc.) meet monthly at senior centers and other community locations. Feel free to call our **Information and Referral Department** to request a list of local support groups.

Medication Education for Drug Safety (MEDS) Program

Our staff Pharmacist can provide medication reviews to identify possible side effects, drug interactions, and safety concerns.

Speed Referrals
